This course is designed to prepare you to support the teacher and the delivery of curriculum within a school, as well as introduce the skills necessary to help children develop self-esteem, independence and skills for learning.

Duration

31 weeks part-time. One evening a week.

Learning Method

This course is currently fully delivered in the classroom which is supported by a weekly practice in placement. This is under regular review.

Entry Requirements

You should have GCSE Grade A*-C/Grade 9-4 in either Mathematics or English, or an equivalent qualification. If you only have one of these qualifications, you must be willing to undertake the other alongside this course to support your future role as a teaching assistant or to enable progression onto Level 3 Diploma.

We offer Functional Skills courses in English and Maths and can create an individual learning programme tailored to your needs.

You will also be required to commit to and complete a practice placement for the duration of the course with a minimum attendance of 5 hours per week. You will need to secure your placement yourself prior to the start of the course.

You will need to complete a DBS for this course and in doing so will need to provide 3 ID documents. These can include; Birth Certificate, Driving License, Passport, Bank statement or Utility bill.

What will I learn?

By combining practical experience with theoretical learning to encourage both understanding and the development of professional skills, this course supports the current Government initiative to develop the role of school support staff.

Placement experience can be gained within primary, secondary or sixth form settings and maybe in a voluntary or contractually employed capacity.
