
AAT Accounting Level 3 Advanced Diploma



AAT Accounting

This Level 3 course builds on the topics covered in the AAT Level 2 Certificate and extends on the areas covered to the completion of final accounts. The programme is designed to provide the maximum flexibility to students from a wide range of circumstances and diverse backgrounds, allowing them to gain skills and knowledge based on nationally agreed standards of competence.

Duration

34 weeks part-time.

Learning Method

This course is delivered through blended learning. This comprises of 1 day in class during the week, and 1 class being online.

What will I learn?

- This qualification will build on topics that were covered in Level 2 and extend on the areas covered to the completion of final accounts.
- Will help students learn how to deal with a wide range of circumstances and diverse backgrounds which will allow students to gain skills and knowledge based on nationally agreed standards of competence.
- Skills needed for a range of financial processes including maintaining cost accounting records, advanced bookkeeping, and the preparation of financial reports and returns.

Entry Requirements

You should have a Level 2 Certificate in Accounting or an A Level in Accounting at Grade A*-C.

You should also have GCSE Maths and English at Grade C/4 or an equivalent qualification. Applicants without these qualifications but sufficient life / work experience will need to complete an AAT skills test to assess their eligibility. The ability to word process under time constraints is also essential.
