# Supporting Teaching and Learning

**This course is designed to prepare you to support the teacher and the delivery of curriculum within a school, as well as introduce the skills necessary to help children develop self-esteem, independence and skills for learning.**

## Duration

30 weeks part-time.

## Price

£708.50\* FREE subject to eligibility.

## Learning Method

This course is currently fully delivered in the classroom. This is under regular review.

## Entry Requirements

You should have GCSE Grade A\*-C/Grade 9-4 in either Mathematics or English, or an equivalent qualification. If you only have one of these qualifications, you must be willing to undertake the other alongside this course.

We offer Functional Skills courses in English and Maths and can create an individual learning programme tailored to your needs.

You will also be required to commit to and complete a practice placement for 24 weeks with a minimum attendance of 5 hours per week. You should arrange this placement yourself prior to the start of the course.

You will need to complete a DBS for this course and in doing so will need to provide 3 ID documents. These can include; Birth Certificate, Driving License, Passport, Bank statement or a letter.

## What will I learn?

By combining practical experience with theoretical learning to encourage both understanding and the development of professional skills, this course supports the current Government initiative to develop the role of school support staff.

Placement experience can be gained within primary, secondary or sixth form settings and maybe in a voluntary or contractually employed capacity.

### Funding

This course may be FREE if you...

- You are unemployed (and looking for work) and in receipt of JSA, Universal Credit, Child Benefit and Carers Allowance\*.
- You are earning less than £18,525 annually (before tax)\*.

If this criteria doesn't apply to you, then you could also either pay in three instalments or pay the fee in full.

\*Please note that if you are aged between 19-23, you will need a full L2 qualification to access this funding.
