The Level 2 Certificate in Accounting is ideal for anyone wishing to study accountancy and finance alongside a range of complementary business and personal skills. The purpose of the Level 2 Certificate in Accounting is to offer the foundation accounting knowledge needed to progress to employment or further study in accountancy and finance, alongside business and personal skills that are transferable to any sector and additional business knowledge relevant to accountancy.

34 weeks part-time.

Learning Method

This course is fully delivered in the classroom.

What will I learn?

- Foundation knowledge needed to progress into employment or further study in accountancy and finance as well as business and personal skills that are transferable to any sector.
- Developing skills in double-entry bookkeeping.
- Understand how to use journals, control accounts, and a trial balance.
- Gain understanding of accounting software packages and how to process financial information in accordance with company procedures and schedules.
- How to provide information to colleagues, suppliers and customers as required.

Entry Requirements

You should have good numeracy and literacy skills and have GCSE Maths and English at Grade C/4, or an equivalent qualification. The ability to word process under time constraints is also essential.

You are also required to become a member of the AAT professional body and will need to pay the AAT membership fee, which is charged once per level.
