

Welcome to Level 2 Art & Design; this course aims to provide students with the opportunity to gain a nationally recognized qualification to enter employment in art and design or to progress onto Level 3 courses in Art and Design or Graphic Design. It will also help students to develop a range of skills and techniques, personal qualities and attitudes essential for success in their future career.

To aid students in reaching their full potential, the college boasts industry standard workshop facilities. Units of study will include areas such as drawing, communication skills and exploring materials, techniques and processes. Whilst completing these units, students gain skills which can be developed further in their very own Final Major Project, which is completed at the end of the course. This final project is marked as Pass, Merit or Distinction and forms the final overall grade for the course.

This course is seen as a stepping stone and part of the journey of becoming ready to progress onto higher level qualifications, by developing the creative, practical skills students need to become successful artists or designers. As well as experimenting with a range of media and ideas, students also learn how to evaluate their own work and capture their thought processes.

To enhance studies at college, students have the opportunity to get involved in trips and visits to complete primary research for projects. This can include trips to places of interest such as Blackpool Zoo and Liverpool World Museum. As well as practical work for this course, students will also complete work experience, giving them vital skills when working with a client.
