

Welcome to Level 3 Art & Design at Runshaw College. This two year course aims to provide students with the opportunity to gain a nationally recognised qualification and equips students with the skills, knowledge and understanding necessary to progress into further or higher education, or training and apprenticeships in the creative sector. It is a stimulating and demanding course designed for those who have an interest in the visual arts, giving students the opportunity to explore and develop their creativity.

The course encourages learning across diverse disciplines and it is anticipated that in year one, students will develop practical skills in specialist areas such as fine art, textiles, three dimensional design and photography / lens based media. Students learn how to creatively experiment with media, to use visual language to communicate themes, concepts and messages, and how to use the work of other artists/designers/makers to inspire their own work. The broad content of year 1 is designed to teach a variety of skills and enable students to identify their strengths and passions within more focused pathways.

In year two, students become more specialist and create a more in-depth portfolio to support the choices they make regarding future progression. Our aim is for students to develop their own style and artistic personality.

As well as developing students' professional practice in the visual arts, the Extended Diploma also advances a range of transferable skills that may be beneficial in other subject areas. By the end of the course, our students demonstrate initiative, team working, problem solving, literacy, numeracy and presentation skills, amongst others.

To enhance studies at college and to inform ideas, students have the opportunity to undertake primary research at inspirational locations and visit museum and art gallery collections.

Our students are extremely successful with their progression from the course including high profile universities such as London College of Fashion,

Glasgow School of Art, Falmouth University and Manchester Metropolitan University. To further enhance studies at the college, our students must source and participate in an external work placement in a relevant industry.
