We have strong links with industry and higher education. Each year we have guest lectures from universities to help complement the A-Level course and support wider reading. Our annual A-Level Business Future's Week welcomes nearly 40 guest speakers ensuring that our students discover the huge range of options that are available to them once they have completed their A-Level course.
