The course is developed to provide progression opportunities to Higher Education, Employment or an Apprenticeship in the Digital sector. Entry Requirements:

Level 1: a minimum of 1 x Grade 3, 1 x Grade 2 and Maths or English Language at Grade 2.

Level 2: a minimum of 4 x Grade 3s and you must have Grade 4 in either Maths or English.

Level 3: a minimum of 5 x Grade 4s, including grade 4 in English Language.
