T Level **Assisting with Healthcare Science**

What will I learn?

This course develops the skills and knowledge required for those who wish to pursue a career in the Healthcare industry. You will enjoy industry experience in carefully selected placements including hospitals and healthcare settings and study units covering different aspects of working within this sector. All students will study a combination of the three sciences of Biology, Chemistry and Physics in detail, plus core components that are not taught in traditional science qualifications, such as working in the health and science sector, infection prevention, clinical practice and patient care. The occupational specialism in assisting with the healthcare science in Year 2 involves practical work including collection and analysis of specimens for diagnosis and treatment, contributions to patient care by producing reliable data and image collection.

How will I be assessed?

Assessment is via a combination of exams, discussions, projects and coursework. In Year 1, there are two core exams and an employer set project, and three coursework assessments in Year 2. At the end of the two years, students will be awarded an overall grade of either Pass, Merit, Distinction or Distinction*.

As part of achieving the overall T Level programme, you also get the opportunity to complete a minimum of 315 hours industry placement (approximately 45 days).

What enrichment can I look forward to?

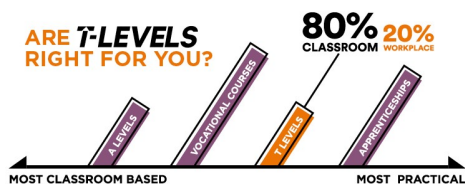
You can look forward to a range of enrichment that supports your learning, including hospital visits, educational trips, employer guest speakers and wide range of Science academies.

What progression is there?

Employment in the science and health industry, higher-level apprenticeship or university are all options at the end of the two years.

Entry Requirements:

A minimum of 5 x Grade 4s, including English & Maths. Grade 5 in English Language & 54 Science. Must have a Disclosure and Barring Service check (DBS).
