

English Functional Skills

Our Functional Skills English course is designed to develop your existing literacy skills. The three core elements of study are reading, writing and speaking & listening. Our aim is to provide you with English skills that will help you succeed in your everyday life, at work and further courses of study.

Duration

17 weeks.

What will I learn?

The courses will focus on reading, technical writing skills, planning and structuring written tasks and creating a range of documents such as letters, emails and forum posts. In addition, you will develop your speaking and listening skills, communicating effectively in discussions and presenting to others.

Options for the Course Structure:

On-Site

1 x 3 hour lesson per week
Daytime and evening classes available
The classes are delivered by one of our English
tutors and your progress is regularly reviewed.
You are also required to complete up to 3 hours
of directed study out of class.

There are 3 components to the course: reading, writing and speaking & listening. You need to pass all 3 in order to gain the qualification.

Online

This option is available for Level 2 and offers a more independent form of study. You will be working on-line on topics that are designed to meet your specific areas of need. Your progress is monitored by our tutors and drop-in sessions are available as appropriate.

The first 4 weeks of this course are explicitly for speaking & listening and you would be required

to attend an on-line day or evening session for this. The sessions will last 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours. You must pass this component before you will be given access to the rest of the platform to work through the reading and writing elements independently.

You will have access to the Runshaw College online platform and will be able to take your examinations online.

There are 3 components of study: reading, writing and speaking & listening. You need to pass all 3 in order to gain the qualification.
