# AAT Accounting

**This Level 3 course builds on the topics covered in the AAT Level 2 Certificate and extends on the areas covered to the completion of final accounts. The programme is designed to provide the maximum flexibility to students from a wide range of circumstances and diverse backgrounds, allowing them to gain skills and knowledge based on nationally agreed standards of competence.**

## Learning Method

**Daytime** class - this course is delivered fully in the classroom.

**Evening** class - hybrid model (mix of in class and online classes)

## What will I learn?

- This qualification will build on topics that were covered in Level 2 and extend on the areas covered to the completion of final accounts.
- Will help students learn how to deal with a wide range of circumstances and diverse backgrounds which will allow students to gain skills and knowledge based on nationally agreed standards of competence.
- Skills needed for a range of financial processes including maintaining cost accounting records, advanced bookkeeping, and the preparation of financial reports and returns.

## Entry Requirements

You should have GCSE Maths and English at Grade C/4 or an equivalent qualification AND (any of the below).

- Level 2 Cert in Accounting
- A-Level in Accounting
- 'A' levels in Business/Economics/Maths
- BTEC Business L3
- Relevant degree

Learners without one of the options above may be able to apply **if they have work experience** and come out as Level 3 on the AAT Skills Check.

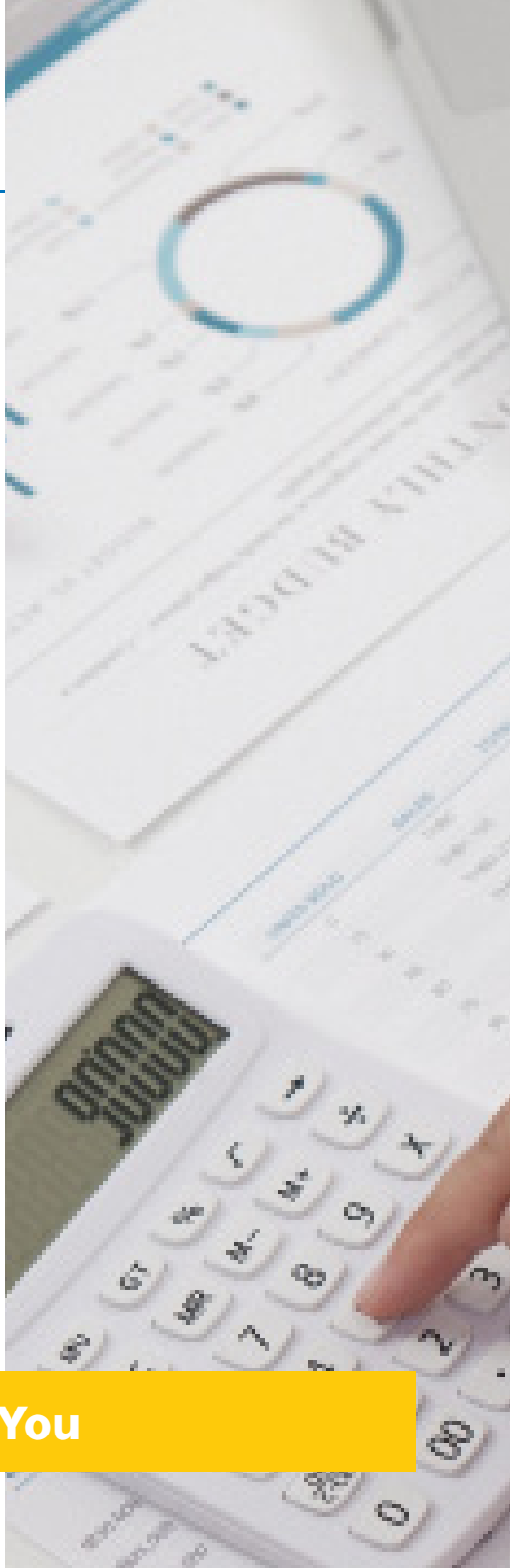

## Funding

This course may be FREE if you...

- are unemployed, looking for work and in receipt of an approved benefit.
- are employed, earning less than £25,750 a year before tax (evidence required)

If this criteria does not apply to you, then you could either:

- ask your employer to sponsor you
- pay in four consecutive instalments
- pay the fee in full
- apply for an Advanced Learner Loan to help pay for the course fees.
